Logee's Greenhouses

Like many other Connecticut business owners, the Logee's Greenhouses have turned to renewable energy. As an agricultural business that cares deeply about the environment, the switch to solar energy was a no brainer.

The system was designed and installed by local solar leaders, PurePoint Energy. To ensure big savings and to maximize the limited space on the east-west facing roofs, optimizers were used to mitigate shading concerns and snow buildup challenges.

In year one alone, the system is estimated to save Logee's \$9,390 in electric bills.

This system is estimated to produce an average of 51,064 kWh of electricity per year.
